

HOW TO BUY A TICKET/HOSPITALITY



Online (Subject to £1 per ticket booking fee)

- Tickets can be purchased online 24-hrs a day, seven days a week and up to TWO hours before kick-off on matchday.
- Visit dcfc.co.uk and click 'TICKETS & HOSPITALITY' then, under the 'TICKETS' section, click 'HOME TICKETS'.
- Use your email address and password to log into the system. If you have not purchased a ticket before, you will have to register for a Fan ID.
- If there is an issue, click the 'forgot password' link on the login page. If the issue persists, email Ticket.Office@dcfc.co.uk.
- Tickets can be collected from the Pride Park Stadium Ticket Office, which is open Monday to Saturday 10am-4pm. and at least **THREE** hours before kick-off and up to half-time on matchday or posted up to **72-hrs** before matchday (subject to £2 per transaction postage fee) or delivered via the 'print at home' option.



PHONE (SUBJECT TO £1 PER TICKET BOOKING FEE)

- Tickets can be purchased by phone Monday to Saturday 10am-4pm and up to ONE hour before kick-off on matchday.
- Ensure your contact details are readily available including Fan ID, Full Name, Full Address, and Date of Birth before calling 0871 472 1884* and selecting Option 1.
- Tickets can be collected from the Pride Park Stadium Ticket Office, which is open Monday to Saturday 10am-4pm and at least THREE hours before kick-off and up to half-time on matchday or posted up to 72-hrs before matchday (subject to £2 per transaction postage fee).



IN PERSON (no Booking FEE)

• Tickets can be purchased in person from the Pride Park Stadium Ticket Office, which is open Monday to Saturday 10am-4pm and at least **THREE** hours before kick-off and up to half-time on matchday.



HOSPITALITY

• For seasonal or matchday hospitality packages, please follow the same online link as above and navigate to the 'Hospitality' section, which will show you all available options for purchase, or call 0871 472 1884 and select Option 3 or email hospitality@dcfc.co.uk.

WHICH STAND SHOULD I CHOOSE?

WEST STAND

offers the highest price tickets in both upper and lower tiers directly above and adjacent to the players tunnel and team dugouts and is generally regarded as one of the more reserved stands.

SOUTH-WEST CORNER

offers mid-price tickets in upper tier only and can get a little noisy with some of the supporters' choice of language and behaviour not considered suitable for everyone.

NORTH-WEST CORNER

SOUTH STAND -

offers the lowest price tickets in both upper and lower tiers and is regarded as being the most animated with some of the supporters' choice of language and behaviour not considered suitable for everyone.

← NORTH STAND

NORTH-EAST CORNER

offers the lowest price tickets in both upper and lower tiers and popular with families. This stand is generally regarded as one of the more reserved stands.

offers mid-price tickets in both upper and lower

tiers and houses our dedicated family area

UPPER TIER


offers the highest price tickets in both upper and lower tiers, directly opposite the hospitality facilities and can get a little noisy, especially in the sections adjacent to the South-East Corner, which is segregated and only available to away supporters.

LOWER TIER

(upper blocks F, G and H and lower block F). EAST STAND

Seats within the lower tier are subject to inclement weather



Reporting Incidents and Anti-Social Behaviour

Derby County Football Club advocate a strict policy of zero-tolerance towards supporters who act or express racist, homophobic or aggressive views towards others. Should you see or hear any behaviours which you believe do not adhere to these policies and which we believe are unwelcome at Pride Park Stadium, we would urge you to please ask one of the matchday stewards to report the incident or concern to the club, enabling us to act accordingly.

Matchday Text Service

Whilst it is a rare occurrence at Pride Park Stadium, there are times when the behaviour of other fans may be regarded as in unacceptable, you can report directly to Derby County Match Control through our matchday text service. Start your text with DCFC then type your message to 88440. Please include as much information as possible including the Stand, Row, and Seat details of where the incident occurred.

Your text will be treated in the strictest of confidence as we identify and deal with the perpetrators.



Guidance for Adults Bringing Children

We offer all parents/guardian(s) the opportunity to collect a free-of-charge wristband from Rammie and Ewie's Activity Zone, that their child can wear on the day of the game. Parents/guardian(s) can write their contact details, stand, and seat number on the wristband, and then if their child was to become separated from them or felt unsafe, they could then approach a steward or member of staff and show their wristband, who will then duly contact the parent/guardian(s).



SEASON TICKETS AND MEMBERSHIPS

Season Tickets

If you have purchased or renewed a seat on a seasonal basis, you will receive a pre-loaded Season Ticket Card automatically providing you with turnstile access for every home league match during the season.

Young Rams Membership

Away Ticket Membership

Away Ticket Membership holders receive priority for purchasing away league match tickets during the following 48-hour 'windows' after the match has been announced:

Window 1: 2024/25 Away Ticket Members who attended **15** or more Away League Matches during the 2022/23 season.

Window 2: 2024/25 Away Ticket Members who attended **10** or more Away League Matches during the 2022/23 season.

Window 3: 2024/25 Away Ticket Members who attended **5** or more Away League Matches during the 2022/23 season.

Window 4: Remaining 2024/25 Away Ticket Membership Holders

Window 5: 2024/25 Season Ticket Holders.

Window 6: General Sale

2023/24 season attendance is only registered for away league match tickets purchased from Derby County Ticket Office. Only one ticket can be issued per Fan ID (subject to availability).


Ticketing Terms & Conditions

Traffic Exclusion Zone/Resident Parking Zones

In the interest of pedestrian safety, a traffic exclusion zone is imposed around Pride Park Stadium on matchdays. It is in operation from 90 minutes prior to kick off and up to 60 minutes after the final whistle with precise timing dependent upon traffic and pedestrian movement on Derwent Parade and Royal Way.

Resident parking zones are in operation on matchdays with parking fines issued if contravened. The club advises supporters, where possible, to use official car parks.

Matchday First Aid Medical Provision

If a supporter becomes unwell at Pride Park Stadium and requires medical assistance, then we strongly advise that the nearest steward is made aware who will ensure that the crowd medical team is notified, and that appropriate care is provided. It is important to note that the responsibilities of the crowd medical teams are separate to club medical support teams for players.

Medication

Please email **slo@dcfc.co.uk** or call **01332 667528** if you need to bring essential medication into Pride Park Stadium.

Cashless

Apart from external catering vendors, Pride Park Stadium is a cashless environment accepting only contactless, debit card and credit card as means of payment.

Bag Policy

Bags are subject to search and must be no larger than **45cm** x **30cm** x **15cm**. There is no on-site storage facility for oversized bags.

Supporters are prohibited from bringing refreshments into Pride Park Stadium. However, if a supporter has specific dietary or sustenance requirements because of a medical condition, please contact us on **disability**. access@dcfc.co.uk in advance of attending the game.

Additionally, supporters must be a minimum of 18 years old to purchase and/or consume alcohol in Pride Park Stadium. Photo ID may be requested to determine proof of age.

Flag Policy

Obviously, the club wants an exciting atmosphere at Pride

Park Stadium and encourages all supporters to bring flags and banners, however these must adhere to our guidelines:

- The flag/banner is manufactured to British Standards and has been certified as fire retardant.
- The flag/banner is displayed in a suitable location and does not obstruct LED advertising, signage, exit routes, restrict the views of other supporters or in any way compromise the safe operation of the stadium.
- The flag/banner should be presented to the matchday stewards and safety team prior to entry to Pride Park Stadum where they will be inspected for compliance with the guidelines.
- The club reserves the right to confiscate any flags/banners brought into the ground that have not been approved prior to entry.
- The content of the flag/banner cannot be derogatory, nor should it contain any language or wording deemed to be potentially inflammatory or offensive to any individual or group. Additionally, defamatory, political or offensive slogans will not be permitted.
- The use of surfers or surfer-style banners designed to be passed over supporters' heads will not be allowed after kick-off.
- Any surfers or banners brought into the stadium without being approved by the Stadium Operator will be confiscated.
- A register of banners and surfers which meet fire safety criteria will be kept by the Stadium Operator and Matchday Director. - A copy will be given to the Safety Officer to assist stewards in assessing approved articles.
- The Stadium Operator reserves the right to change this policy as it deems fit or as required by the Local Authority, Football Authorities or any other body that helps to determine the safety of spectators at the Stadium.
- Whilst the Stadium Operator endeavours to take good care of banners and surfers that are brought into the Stadium, it accepts no responsibility for any loss or damage that may occur at any time.

Specification:

- The flagpole should be no bigger than **7mm** in diameter and 1000mm in length.
- The flagpole material should be plastic and rounded/ covered at each end.
- Any item above the area of **60cm x 100cm** must be flame retardant and have a fire safety certificate to prove so, provided in advance of matchday.
- Supporters wishing to introduce larger/surfer flags and banners must contact the Supporter Liaison Officer and Matchday Director in advance via **slo@dcfc.co.uk** and must be presented at least three working days before matchday with the appropriate fire certification.



ENTERING THE STADIUM

To ensure that you are able to enter Pride Park Stadium without any issues, it is important that you attempt to access the stadium using the correct turnstile; the turnstile that you should be using will be displayed clearly on your match ticket/season ticket.

Match tickets/season tickets must be used at the correct turnstile (accessible entrances are available in all four stands to those disabled supporters that require to use one and are clearly signed).

Please note, turnstiles open 90 minutes ahead of kick-off.

Re-admittance

There is no re-admittance to the stadium if you leave prior to the end of the fixture. We do however make allowances for smoking within a specific cordoned area. For further information please contact our stewarding team who can direct you accordingly.



Here to Help

If you need assistance in finding your way around Pride Park Stadium there are a number of outlets of information available to you.

Firstly, our stewarding team are strategically located in their high visibility uniforms on hand to give assistance with any questions which you may have, they have a high knowledge of local amenities and stadium access; if they do not know a piece of information, they will endeavour to find someone that does.

Should you have any questions, need help with directions or just want to find out what's going on around the ground, don't hesitate to speak to our friendly Matchday Supporter Liaison Officers! Easily identifiable through their blue 'Fans First' high-viz jackets, you can find them outside Pride Park Stadium from 90 minutes ahead of kick-off on a matchday.

REFRESHMENTS

On the Concourse

Our concourse catering provides a variety of refreshments, with food options such as pies, and children's meal deals, alongside various options for soft, hot and alcoholic drinks prior to kick-off and at half-time. However, supporters are not permitted to take alcoholic beverages out of the concourse in view of the pitch.

Hospitality

Enjoy the season in style with a Hospitality Package at Pride Park Stadium. Ranging from an unlimited Chef's buffet table in our Captain's Club, to a five course a la carte fine dining experience in the much sought-after Clough Taylor Lounge.

- Open 7 days a week at Pride Park Stadium:
- Usual hours are Monday to Saturday from 9am-5pm,
 Sunday 10am-4pm may change dependent on matchday timings (Bank Holidays operate on Sunday hours)



Online

You can purchase online at **dcfcmegastore.co.uk**, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week (please note the online service is separate from the store)

- Currently there is no click and collect option available in store
- All orders that require an exchange or refund must be sent back to the online store (click the Help Tab under Customer Service on the website for instructions on how to do this)

Returns Policy

In addition to your statutory rights, items can be returned or exchanged within 30 days of purchase for a full refund or exchange of equivalent value, provided the item is still in its original condition and accompanied by an itemised receipt.

Personalised items are exempt from our returns policy and cannot be exchanged or refunded. Your statutory rights are not affected by our returns policy.

Please note that items purchased online cannot be returned to store. Please visit **dcfcmegastore.co.uk** for more information.

For refunds, please allow 5-10 working days for the amount to appear in your bank account. This time frame is dictated by your bank or card issuer and is outside of our control. Your refund will be credited to the same card with which you made your original purchase.


Our home supporters are very welcome to come and take part in and enjoy a variety of exciting, family-friendly activities:








Make sure you have everything you need ready to enjoy the game, including your ticket, checking the weather, and planning your route!


Please note that Pride Park Stadium is a cashless stadium.



Traffic can get busy around the stadium so make sure you arrive within plenty of time.




Wrap up warm if the game is during the winter months; it can get rather cold in the concourses and at your seats!



The DCFCMegastore is in the North-East corner of the stadium.



If you are collecting tickets our ticket collection point for home supporters is located just outside the Ticket Office on the West side of the stadium; we would advise that you to arrive at least 45 minutes prior to kick-off, as you will most likely have to queue.



For all ticket access issues, please go to the North Stand Access windows. Located to the left of Harrison's Hub.



There are plenty of food and drink options inside the concourses and around the ground, look out for the kids' meal deals if you're a family attending.



Turnstiles open 90 minutes before kick-off across all stands.




The warm-up normally begins 45 minutes before kick-off - don't miss the teams being put through their paces!



Take your seats at least 10 minutes before kickoff so you can enjoy the atmosphere as the crowd welcome the teams to the pitch.



Enjoy the game, but if you do have any issues or concerns alert your nearest steward who will be happy to help.



DID YOU KNOW?

- Derby County is one of the 12 founder members of the Football League.
- Derby is the only club to have staged England matches at three different home grounds.
- The highest home attendance was 41,826 against Tottenham Hotspur in 1969.
- Derby's biggest win was 12-0 in the UEFA Cup in 1976 against Irish team Finn Harps
- The biggest attendance to see a Derby game was 120,000 at Real Madrid in the European Cup (Champions League)

- The first foreign player to play for the club was Tewfik Abdullah, nicknamed 'Toothpick'
- Derby's first player to score in the World Cup was Mark Wright during Italia 90
- The Preston vs Derby County match in 2020 was the first ever league game to be played in the month of July
- Youngest player: Mason Bennett, 15 years 99 days vs Middlesbrough, 22nd October 2011.
- Oldest player: Peter Shilton, 42 years 164 days vs Watford, 29th February 1992.


